Signature Blade Craft

Blade Composition:

Crafted from 80CrV2, a high quality 5160 steel, It is a high high carbon chrome-vanadium steel and is very tough and hold a sharp edge very well

Blade Tenacity:

Hardened to an optimal hardness, ensuring unmatched edge retention and resilience.

Guard Composition:

Fashioned from premium 316 Stainless Steel, offering superior corrosion resistance and elegance and durability.

Spacer and pommel nut Fabrication:

316 Stainless Steel

Handle Craftsmanship:

Adorned with African Black Wood (*Dalbergia melanoxylon*), an African hard wood that is heavy, dark and luxurious. It is the 7th hardest wood in the world and the most expensive. The handle wood comes from a tree "rescued" from a building site in Marloth Park. The blade is safeguarded by a unique protector also crafted from Tambootie, internally lined with genuine leather and dual magnets keeping the knife in place.

Blade protector:

The blade is carried in a handmade heavy duty genuine leather sheath.

Edition Number:

This knife is the 50th hand-made piece, marking its exclusivity.

Maintenance Advisory:

To preserve the knife's bespoke quality and finish, it is advised against washing in a dishwasher. The elevated temperatures can compromise the integrity of the handle's natural oils. We recommend hand washing and a routine light oiling of the handle using the provided premium oil, ensuring its enduring beauty and function.
